## Apostles Given Enduement to Sustain Them until Pentecost; the Lord's Prophecy of His Indwelling of Believers: Current Positional Truth, John 14:20

- 3) During this ten-day interim, the Holy Spirit sustained and protected them from demonic assault.
- 4) We can only imagine the satanic pressure and strategy devised against these men who were left without the Lord's divine protection, yet they were not left as orphans but were sustained by the Holy Spirit's enduement until the indwelling and filling would occur.
- 5) Once Pentecost occurred, the Holy Spirit indwelt them and other believers in Jerusalem. They became members of the Royal Family of God and thus qualified as recipients of a resurrection body at the Rapture of the Church.
- 6) Because Christ was resurrected into eternal life this also shall be the case for the apostles and all other Church Age believers.

**John 14:20 -** "But in that <u>day</u> **[ Pentecost ]** you will know that I ... in My Father, and you in Me, and I in You."

- 1) This verse is the Lord's promise that at Pentecost Jesus will be "in My Father, "which emphasizes the deity of both personalities with emphasis on the attribute of omnipresence that each possesses.
- 2) In addition, each believer in Jerusalem at Pentecost will be baptized by the Holy Spirit into Christ and acquire top-circle assets under current positional truth.
- 3) The Lord's omnipresence will also enable His deity to indwell every Church Age believer beginning with those in Jerusalem at Pentecost.
