

Worship & Service to the Creature, not the Creator, Rom 1:25; Paul Confirms Christ as Creator, Col 1:16-17; Suppression of Truth is a Satanic Strategy

10. Service to the one revered is found in the aorist active indicative of the verb:
λατρεύω, latreuō: The basic Greek meaning is to “render services,” especially where true worship is perverted and misguided.
 aorist: Constative; gathers into a single whole all cosmic acts that are perversions of true worship of God. The true Object is exchanged for a false object which results in idolatry. Idolatry is demonic and thus serves Satan and the most common area of idolatry is deviant sex.
 active: The reversionist produces the action by participating in the deviant acts that result in service to Satan.
 indicative: Declarative; this downward spiral is classified as a historical trend common to reversionists.
11. The false object is revealed next by the singular noun **κτίσις, ktisis** which is correctly translated “creature” and refers to Satan but implies a lifestyle that worships and serves him.
12. This object of worship and service is said to be more readily or willingly preferable than God by the preposition **παρά, para**, plus the accusative article **τόν, ton**, translated “rather than.”
13. The true Object of worship and service is revealed by the aorist active participle of the verb **κτίζω, ktizō**. The verb form of this noun is **κτίσαντα, ktisanta**, and is correctly translated “the One having created.”
14. The legitimate object of worship and service is the Creator and the Creator is Jesus Christ. Scripture leaves no doubt about who the Creator is:
Colossians 1:16 - For by means of Him [Jesus Christ] were all things created [κτίζω, ktizō: from no preexisting materials] in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers—all things were created [κτίζω, ktizō] through Him [διά, dia indicating agency] and for Him [εἰς, eis indicating purpose].
Colossians 1:17 - And He [Jesus Christ] has existed eternally before all things [the angelic race and the universe], and by means of Him [Jesus Christ] all things hold together [intensive perfect active indicative of συνίστημι, sunistēmi: literally: to stand together with; to join parts together into a whole].
15. Why worship Jesus Christ? He is perfect God as well as perfect Man. Personal love is virtuous when directed at a perfect object. Our personal love for Him is manifest by keeping His commandments. Keeping His commandments performs two objectives: worship and service.
16. The problem recognized by Paul is that those who reject Christ as Savior not only begin to suppress the truth of the gospel, they do so by worshipping and serving the god of this world, Satan himself.
17. This suppression, the customary present of *katechō* in Romans 1:18, is said to be habitual; that which is reasonably expected to occur when a person rejects the gospel.

18. This habitual phenomenon has become more and more common in our culture with the advent of Progressive ideology. There are two distinct manifestations of this suppression that have become sacrosanct throughout academia and now broadly accepted as fact throughout the commonwealth.
19. Each of these Progressive doctrines is an obvious challenge to the very existence of the God of this Universe. Each not only denies His existence but in doing so denies the salvation provided by the work of Christ on the cross.

NOTE: The scientific, academic, and political communities of our country have rejected God, therefore, these two Progressive doctrines are obviously based on lies and find their source in the Luciferian conspiracy.
