- 11. By shifting primary importance away from God on to man, academic research and philosophies conjure up human viewpoint conclusions that, to the benighted, become convincing evidence against divine viewpoint.
- 12. Biblical truth is regarded as truth because of belief and trust in its Source. If the Bible is not regarded as immutable, inerrant communication direct from God to man, then it is quite easy to disregard its content.
- 13. Even the viciously powerful lion tires after a short run and remains hungry. The reversionist attempts to run his life in a futile pursuit of happiness fashioned from academic speculation.
- 14. The pursuit entails a long march to failure. The frustration and disappointment must be transferred away from the ideologue and projected on those who oppose them.
- 15. What both humiliates and infuriates them the most is the condemning principle that follows in the second half of verse 10: "But they who seek the Lord shall not be in want of any good thing."
- 16. The verb "seek" is the Qal active participle of *v***jj** (*darash*). Seeking the Lord can only be accomplished by one's interest, inculcation, and application of the Word of God.
- 17. This use of the Qal participle indicates liner action and emphasizes a believer who is consistently positive to biblical instruction and its retention in the soul.
- 18. True positive volition is confirmed when the believer is just as positive during times of prosperity as he is in times of trial and trouble.
- 19. Such was true for David. His spiritual advance was perceived by the Lord who chose him as the one whose line would lead to the Messiah.
