

8. The final link in the Chart Pedigree is found in the prophecy of Isaiah in:

Isaiah 7:14 - Therefore, the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel, God with us.

9. These things we have examined in detail. On the other hand, Messiah must also be Almighty God as was also prophesied to Isaiah who gave us a sign:

Isaiah 9:6 - For a Child will be born to us, a Son will be given to us [**virgin birth, see Isaiah 7:14**]; and the government will rest on His shoulders; and His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

v. 7 - There will be no end to the increase of His government or of peace, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness from then on and forevermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will accomplish this [**millennial reign**].

10. These two verses establish the hypostatic union of Messiah: true humanity inseparably united with undiminished deity in one Person forever.

11. In verse 6, He is identified as “Mighty God” and “Eternal Father.” In verse 7, He will sit “on the throne of David and over his kingdom.”

12. Regarding His “kingdom,” Isaiah records that “justice and righteousness” will continue “forevermore.”

13. For these things to take place, Messiah must be born into the human race, He must die, be buried, and then resurrected from the dead in order to reign over His “kingdom forevermore,” or for all eternity.

14. As these prophecies pile up in the Tanakh, at some point they must be fulfilled in the future, which they are in the New Testament.

15. Prophecies, to be authentic and confidently expected to occur, must present clear revelation about their fulfillments either in whole or in part.

John 1:1 - In a beginning which was not a beginning was the Word [ὁ λόγος (*ho lógos*)], and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (EXT)
