


BELIEVER'S ROAD TO RUIN OR RECOVERY



Description and Biblical Nomenclature of the Loser Believer

- The carnal/fleshly believer (1 Cor. 3:1–3; Rom. 8:7–8)
- A prisoner to the law of sin (Rom. 7:23)
- The wretched believer (Rom. 7:24)
- Living and fulfilling the lusts of the flesh (Gal. 5:16–21)
- Grieving the Holy Spirit (Eph. 4:30)
- Quenching [squelching] the Holy Spirit (1 Thess. 5:19)
- An enemy of the cross of Christ (Phil. 3:18–19)
- The enemy of God (James 4:4)
- A flawed believer (James 1:23–24)
- A double-souled, neurotic, psychotic believer (James 1:8; 4:8)
- Hater of God (John 15:23)

Characteristics of the Loser Believer

- Drifting off-course from grace (Gal. 5:4)
- Coming short of the grace of God (Heb. 12:15)
- The tormented soul (2 Pet. 2:7–8)
- The lukewarm believer (Rev. 3:15–16)
- The shipwrecked believer (1 Tim. 1:19)
- Anti-(against)Christ (1 John 2:18–22; 4:3; 2 John 7)
