

Cause & Effect of *Pipraskō* in Romans 7:14

CAUSE	EFFECT
The sinful nature woos the believer by means of the lust pattern's <i>agents provocateur</i>.	When volition submits to the temptation the believer is “led astray”: <i>pipraskō</i>. (Thought)
Negative volition orders the execution of wheel-tracks of wickedness. (Decision)	Personal sin is willingly carried out. (Action)
Personal sin committed is now unconfessed resulting in the believer being out of fellowship.	The activated wheel-track of wickedness is facilitated in status quo carnality.
