Divine Didactics in Greek

πνευματικοίς masculine plural of (pneumatikoís)

Spiritual Phenomena: the inventory of truth. In Bibliology called Revelation.

REVELATION

God's direct divine influence communicated truth to the minds of biblical writers.

INSPIRATION

Direct divine influence insured their accurate transfer of truth into written languages.

πνευματιχκά neuter plural of (pneumatiká):

Spiritual Systems: Grace Apparatus for Perception or Operation Z

INTERPRETATION

Pastors, guided by the Holy Spirit, discern through hermeneutics the meaning of Scripture.

COMMUNICATION

Verbal conveyance of biblical doctrines to their assigned congregations.

συγκρίνω (sunkrínō)

Illumination:

Believers, guided by the Holy Spirit, are enabled to understand and retain Bible doctrines.

πνευματικῶς (pneumatikốs):

Spirituality: The status quo of the believer post rebound.

πνευματικός (pneumatikós) ILLUMINATION: Believers, guided by the Holy Spirit, are enabled to spiritually discern & retain Bible doctrines,

The System of Divine Didactics:

Revelation, Inspiration, Interpretation, Communication, Illumination Animation

ANIMATION

Believers, enabled by the Holy Spirit, apply resident doctrines to life and circumstances. This is the end result of the several categories of Divine Didactics.
