Revelation 12:17 cf. 13:1a King James cf. NET Bible

Rev. 13:1 – (KJV): And <u>I</u> [John] stood upon the sand of the sea, and <u>I</u> [John] saw a <u>beast</u> [dictator possessed by Lucifer] rise up <u>out of the sea</u> [indicates he is a Gentile] ...

Revelation 12:17 – (NET): So the <u>dragon</u> [Lucifer] became enraged at the <u>woman</u> [regenerate Israel] and went away to make war on the <u>rest of her children</u> [the emerging Jewish Pivot of the Tribulation], those who kept God's commandments and hold to the testimony about Jesus [evangelism].

v. 18 - (NET): And the <u>dragon</u> [Lucifer] stood on the <u>sand of the</u> <u>seashore</u> [he has been kicked out of the 3d heaven and restricted to planet earth].

In the KJV reading of Revelation 13:1, the pronoun "I" in the sentence: "And I [John] stood upon the sand of the sea," is in error. The correct reading is from the NET Bible: "And he stood [3d person singular of ἴστημι (hístēmi): the dragon/Lucifer] on the sand of the seashore."

This corrected sentence belongs in the context of the previous verse. To simplify the alteration, the Nestle-Aland *Greek New Testament* and the NET Bible include it in chapter 12 as verse 18.
