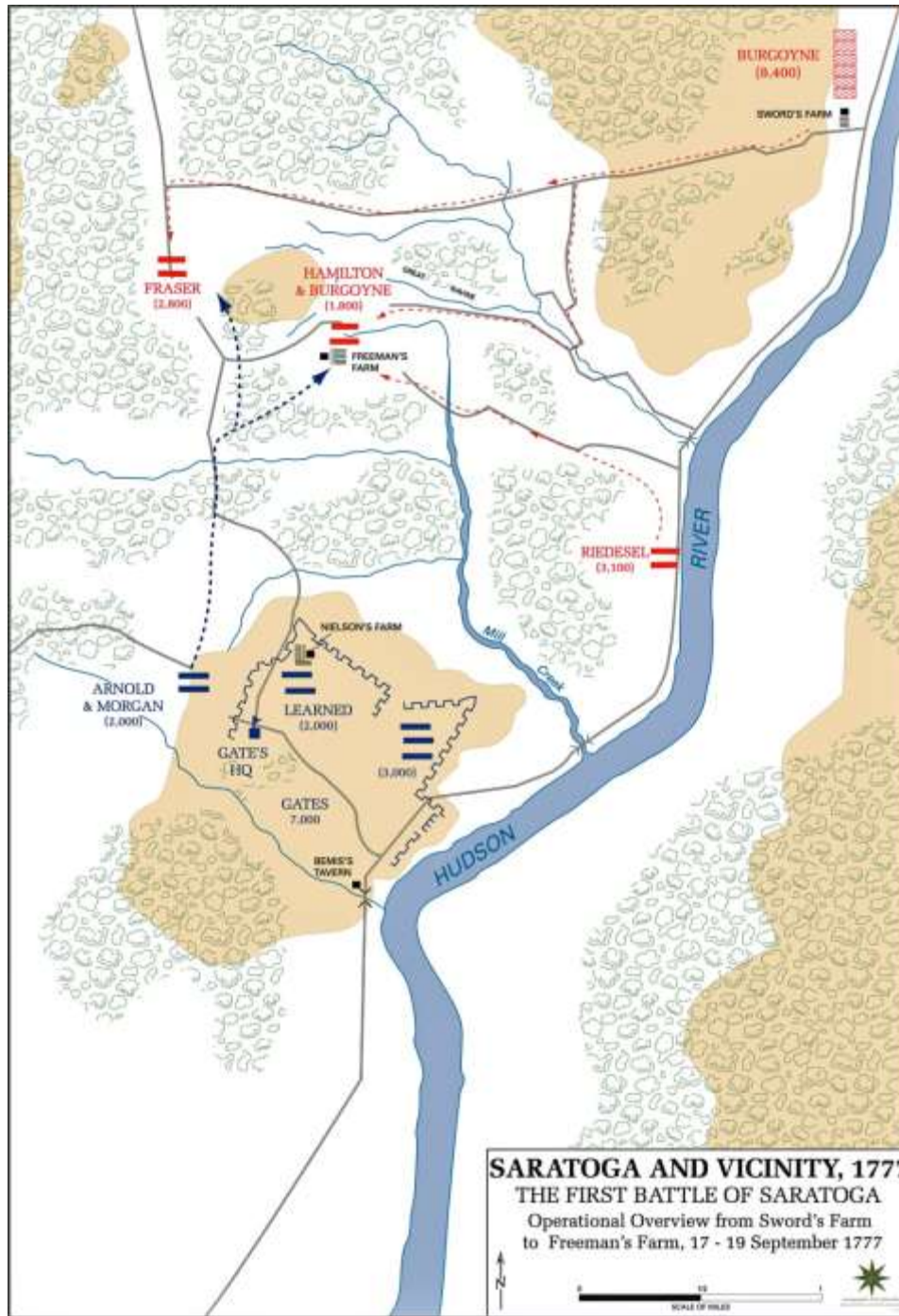


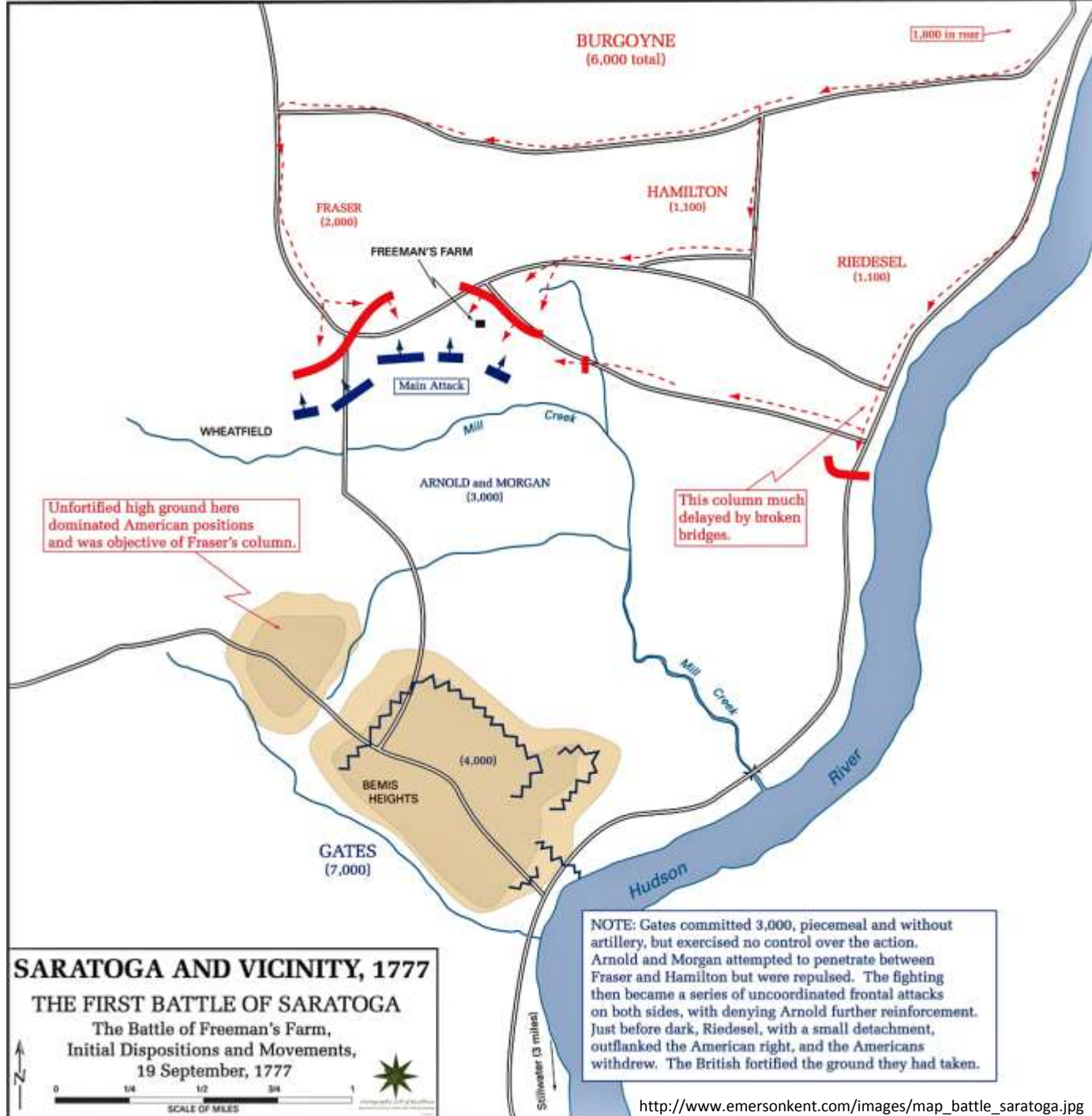

Depiction of *The Death of Jane McCrea*, painted in 1804 by John Vanderlyn.

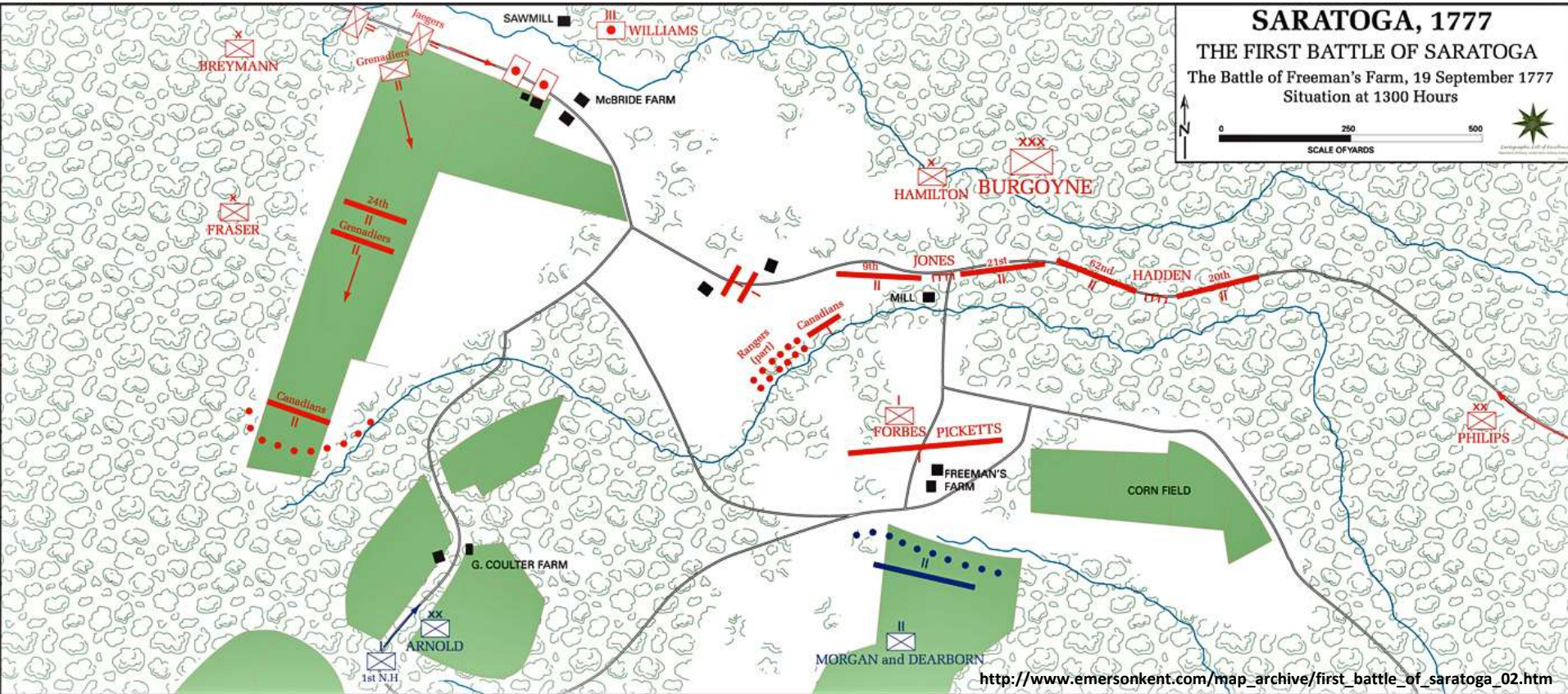
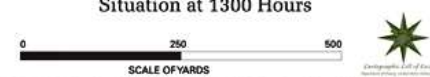

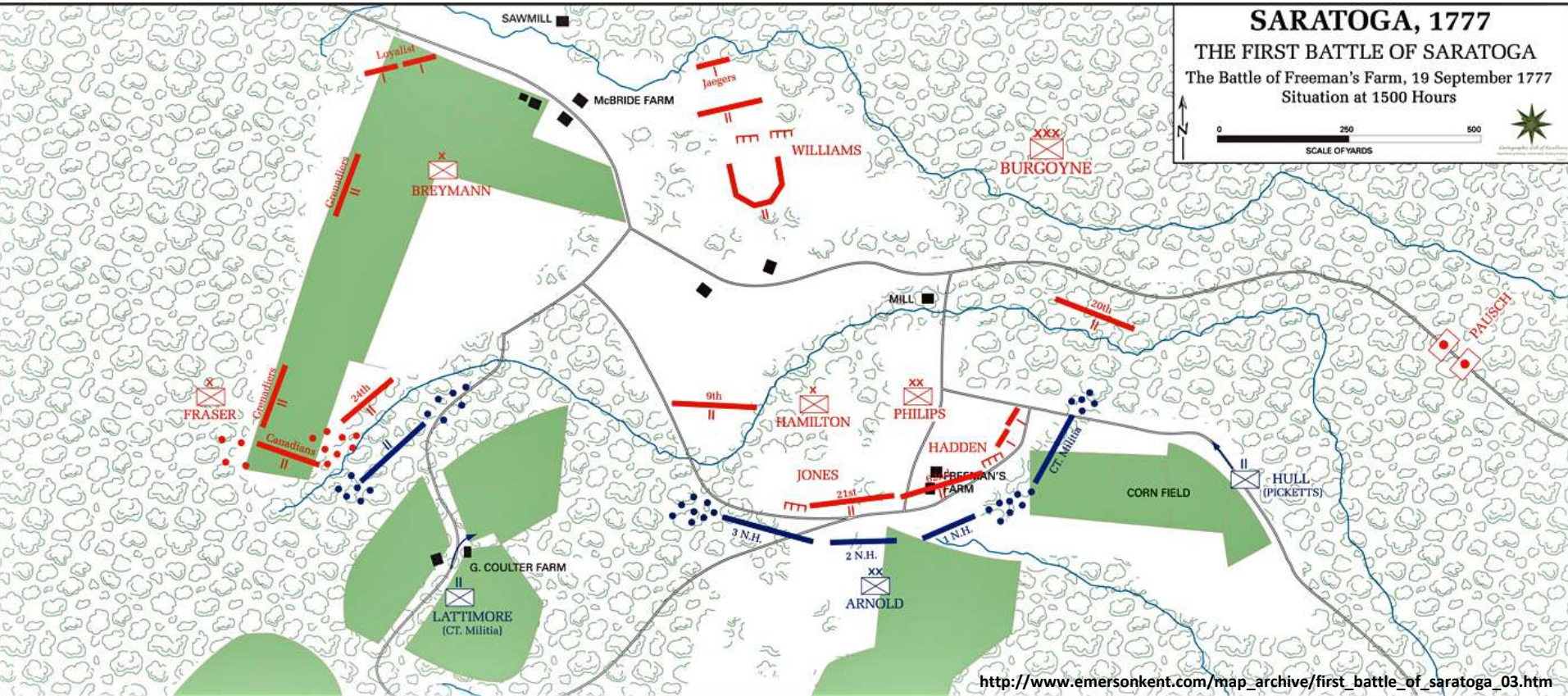
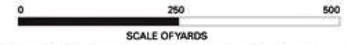
The Battle of Freeman's Farm, 19 September 1777

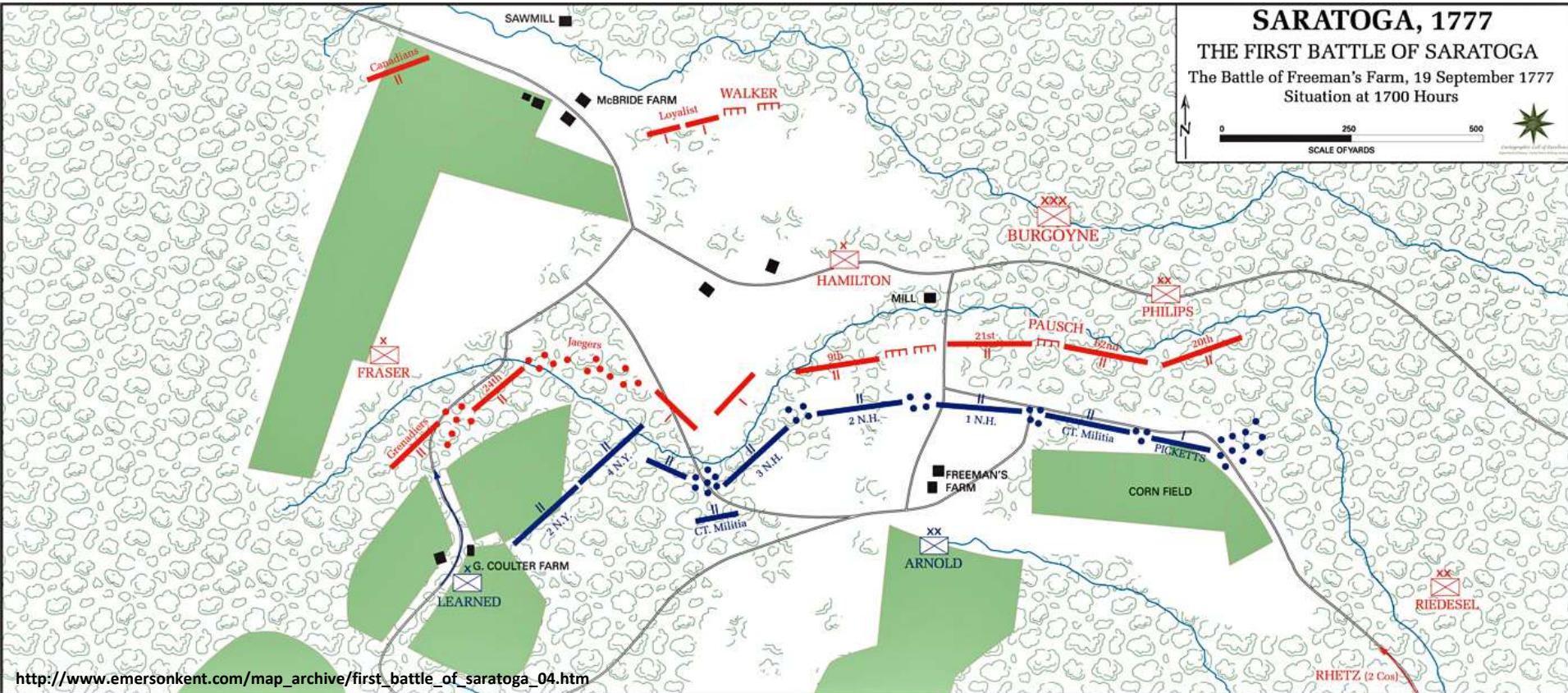
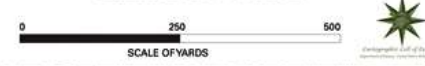
