## Straight Wheel-tracks Provide Capacity for Rewards & Blessings

## Hebrews 12:13a - Be making straight wheel-tracks with your feet ...

Next comes the introduction to a final clause which indicates the purpose to be achieved or the objective to be gained. It begins with the conjunction: *hina* - "*in order that*"

The nominative neuter singular of: cholos - "the crippled one"

The indication that this is a negative purpose clause comes next in the translation. The negative particle: me - "not"

"... in order that the crippled one not ..."

Not what? The agrist passive subjunctive of the verb: ektrepo - "be again dislocated"

aorist - Constative; gathers up into one unit every distraction you will ever face which takes you out of the wheel- tracks toward spiritual maturity.

passive - Recovering reversionist receives the action of the verb of avoiding dislocation as a result of staying in the straight wheel-tracks.

subjunctive - plus the negative particle mh, causes this to be a prohibition against dislocation.
