

Divine Academy: Apostolic Cache; Grace Didactics: Beneficial Deposit, 2 Timothy 1:14

b. The Apostolic Cache

Paul was appointed the twelfth apostle at his salvation and needed to be immediately trained for his special assignment of communicating the gospel to the Gentiles. The most efficient way that the resurrected Lord could accomplish this task was to bring Paul into the third heaven and teach him the doctrine he had to know.

The instruction took place in the ultimate theological seminary, the Divine Academy of Grace Didactics under the professorship of the Academy's Chancellor, Jesus Christ. In all probability the theological training took the same three years required to get the original apostles up to speed but that is only conjecture.

Nevertheless, the target of the Lord's instruction of mystery doctrine was the stream of consciousness and the neural network of the Apostle Paul. Paul therefore became the Apostolic Cache which received the deposit of the Eternal Logos from the teaching ministry of the Living Logos.

We can identify from our three passages the identification of Paul as the Apostolic Cache which received this Heavenly Deposit:

- a. In 2 Corinthians 12:2 Paul speaks of himself in the third person when he writes, "*I know a man in Christ who ... was raptured into the third heaven.*"
- b. Again, in Ephesians 3:3 we note that: "*through revelation the mystery doctrine was made known to me.*"
- c. And finally in Galatians 1:12, Paul writes, "*I received it [knowledge of the Eternal Logos] through a revelation of Jesus Christ.*"

The purpose for these revelations is also revealed in Ephesians 3:4, "*[so that you might] be able to understand my technical knowledge about the mystery of Christ.*"

c. Conclusion

God the Father raptured Paul into heaven so that Jesus Christ might deposit into him the content of the Eternal Logos with emphasis on the mystery doctrines of the New Testament. The instruction took place on the Main Campus of the Divine Academy of Grace Didactics. Heavenly Deposit; Apostolic Cache.

6. The Grace Didactics: Beneficial Deposit, Pastoral Cache

a. The Beneficial Deposit

Upon Paul's return from the Divine Academy in heaven he began his ministry of the gospel. An account of his early travels is included in the Galatians 1 passage:

Galatians 1:17 - ... I went away to Arabia [from where he was raptured into heaven for an unknown period of time], and returned once more to Damascus.

Galatians 1:18 - Then three years later I went up to Jerusalem to become acquainted with Cephas, and stayed with him fifteen days.

Galatians 1:19 - But I did not see any other of the apostles except James, the Lord's brother.

Galatians 1:21 - Then I went into the regions of Syria and Cilicia.

Galatians 2:1 - Then after fourteen years I went up again to Jerusalem ...

This is a period of some 17 years during which Paul organized his theology and began his ministry to the Gentiles of Europe.

Part of his job as an apostle was not only to evangelize the lost and teach doctrine to the saved but also to educate young pastors for leadership in the next generation. Among his students was a young protégé named Timothy.

Paul had acquired, face-to-face from the Lord, knowledge of the mystery doctrines of the New Testament. The very same knowledge which had been deposited into the neural network of the Lord during the Incarnation had been successfully deposited into the neural network of Paul.

Now Paul must again replicate the Eternal Logos into the souls of his converts and especially the pastors of the next generation. The transfer which occurred between Paul and Timothy is called the "*Beneficial Deposit*" in 2 Timothy 1:12, 2 Timothy 1:13, and 2 Timothy 1:14.

The transfer deposit of the Eternal Logos from the soul and brain of Paul to that of Timothy is the emphasis of 2 Timothy 1:13.

2 Timothy 1:13 - Keep on having constellations which form a pattern, mold, or die containing correct doctrinal categories which you have heard from me as the immediate source by means of previously learned doctrines and by means of virtue love which is in Christ Jesus.

Paul then classifies this deposit in the following verse:

2 Timothy 1:14 - Keep on guarding that beneficial deposit through the agency of the Holy Spirit Who dwells in us.
