**Exodus: Fear: Solutions: 11-Logistical Grace; Ramifications of Fear, 1-9** 

Knowledge of logistical grace sustains one's courage towards life. Worry is a by-product of fear. Jesus Christ gave us a series of commands not to worry in:

Matthew 6:31 – "Do not be anxious then, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'With what shall we clothe ourselves?'

Matthew 6:32 - For all these things the Gentiles eagerly seek; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.

Matthew 6:33 - But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you.

Matthew 6:34 - Therefore, do not be anxious for tomorrow; for tomorrow will care for itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own."

There is only one prerequisite for logistical grace: do you possess the righteousness of God?

Faith in Christ results in our justification in which God's perfect righteousness is imputed to us at the moment of salvation.

Romans 5:16 - The gift [Jesus Christ] is not like what occurred through the one who sinned [Adam]. For on the one hand, the judicial verdict came by one transgression [Adam's original sin] resulting in condemnation [the Fall], but on the other hand, the gracious gift [Christ's salvific work on the cross] occurred because of many transgressions resulting in a judicial act of justification [vindication by which God sees His righteousness in us].

Logistical grace guarantees temporal provisions: food, clothing, shelter, water, environment, time, transportation. (Matthew 6:25-Matthew 6:34)

Logistical grace guarantees security provisions: guardian angels, wall of fire, establishment assets (such as authority, privacy, property), and the four divine institutions.

**Psalm 91:11** - He will give His angels charge concerning you to guard you in all your ways.

Matthew 18:10 – "See that you do not despise one of these children, for I say to you, that their angels in heaven continually behold the face of My Father who is in heaven."

Zechariah 2:5 – "I," declares the Lord, "will be a wall of fire around her [Israel], and I will be the glory in her midst."

Logistical grace guarantees spiritual provision: evangelist, pastor-teacher, local church, Bible doctrine, a completed canon, the grace apparatus for perception, the three spiritual skills.

Because logistical grace originates from the source of divine justice, is directed to imputed righteousness and because its daily guarantee is underwritten by divine omnipotence and veracity, then we may conclude that it is also related to the faithfulness of God.

Lamentations 3:21 - This I recall to mind, therefore I have hope.

**Lamentations 3:22** - The Lord's lovingkindnesses indeed never cease for His compassions never fail.

Lamentations 3:23 - They are renewed every morning; great is Your faithfulness.

Lamentations 3:24 - The Lord is my portion, says my soul, Therefore, I have confidence in Him.

## 4. Ramifications of Unrestrained Fear

There are no positive results from applying fear to the problems of life. Since fear is an emotion and not a problem-solving device then the result of applying fear to life is nothing.

Emotion is irrational. Emotion is a feeling emitted by the body in reaction to an outside adversity which is not or cannot be analyzed by the intellect. Failure for the intellect to rationally analyze the outside adversity can be because of ignorance of doctrine or negative volition towards its application under pressure.

Not only is emotion irrational, it also has no content of thought, no common sense, no vocabulary as a tool for analysis, and certainly no doctrinal content.

Fear occurs when outside adversity stimulates vectors of past pain and suffering which you emotionally seek to avoid. Fear often converts the outside adversity into a mental mirage which the deluded intellect interprets as threatening to life, limb, or health.

Emotion originates in the paleocortex's limbic system and is therefore a biochemical, physiological process which results in the physical expression of feeling. When this occurs, the emotions dominate and control the thought process in the soul and what results is an emotional revolt against rational and doctrinal thought.
